**A RESOLUTION OF COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LEON COUNTY, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO ENTER INTO A MULTIPLE-USE AGREEMENT
WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALLOWING THE
INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE
RECOGNITION CAMERAS IN TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
RIGHT-OF-WAY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Leon County Commissioners Court has determined that the addition of Automatic License Plate Recognition (ALPR) cameras will increase public safety and aid the Sheriff's Office in its crime prevention efforts and strategies; and

WHEREAS, Leon County Commissioners Court desires to engage with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and asks that Flock Safety be allowed to place ALPR cameras in the TxDOT right-of-way on behalf of Leon County; and

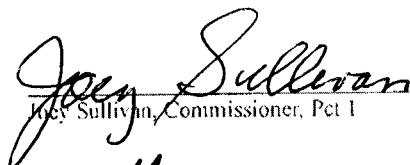

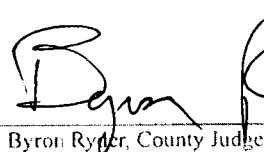
**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY LEON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
